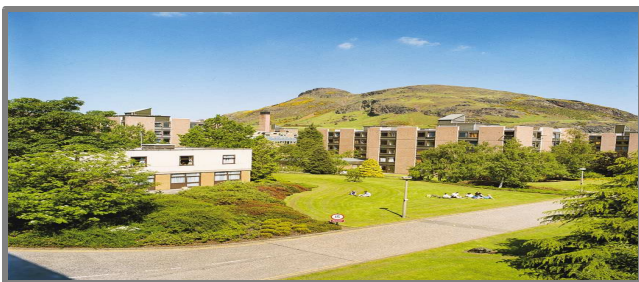

Location

Pollock Halls are the main Halls of Residence for the University of Edinburgh. The site is located close to the city centre, on the edge of Holyrood Park, and directly beneath Arthur's Seat, an extinct volcano.



Services

Bed linen and towels are provided and will be changed every four days. Rooms are cleaned weekly on Saturdays. Washing machines are located in a communal facility, and cost £1.50 per use. Each room has a telephone and outgoing calls can be made with the purchase of a pre-paid phone card.

Catering

Meals are taken in the central refectory, where a variety of healthy and nutritious food is provided on a self-service basis. The caterers place an emphasis on food quality, and a vegetarian option is available every day. Within the refectory, there is also an on-site bar.

Breakfast is served from 7am–10am and dinner from 5.30pm–7.30pm.

Transport to/from the airport

We can arrange a private transfer (arrival GBP 58.00; departure GBP 58.00) where you will be met by a driver at the airport and taken directly to the residence. Alternatively, you could take a taxi (GBP 25.00 approx.). There is also a shuttle bus from the airport to the city centre (GBP 4.50 one way/GBP 7.50 return) or a tram (GBP 5.50 one way/GBP 8.50 return). From there the residence is a 25 min. walk or 5 min. by taxi (GBP 7.00 approx.). There are also buses between the city centre and the residence—bus number 14, 30 and 33.
